New Referees: You must attend and complete a Referee Safe Haven and Regional (Basic) referee class. The classes are taught together.

NOTE: Referees from Regions other than Madison 498 will be issued uniforms and equipment by their home regions.

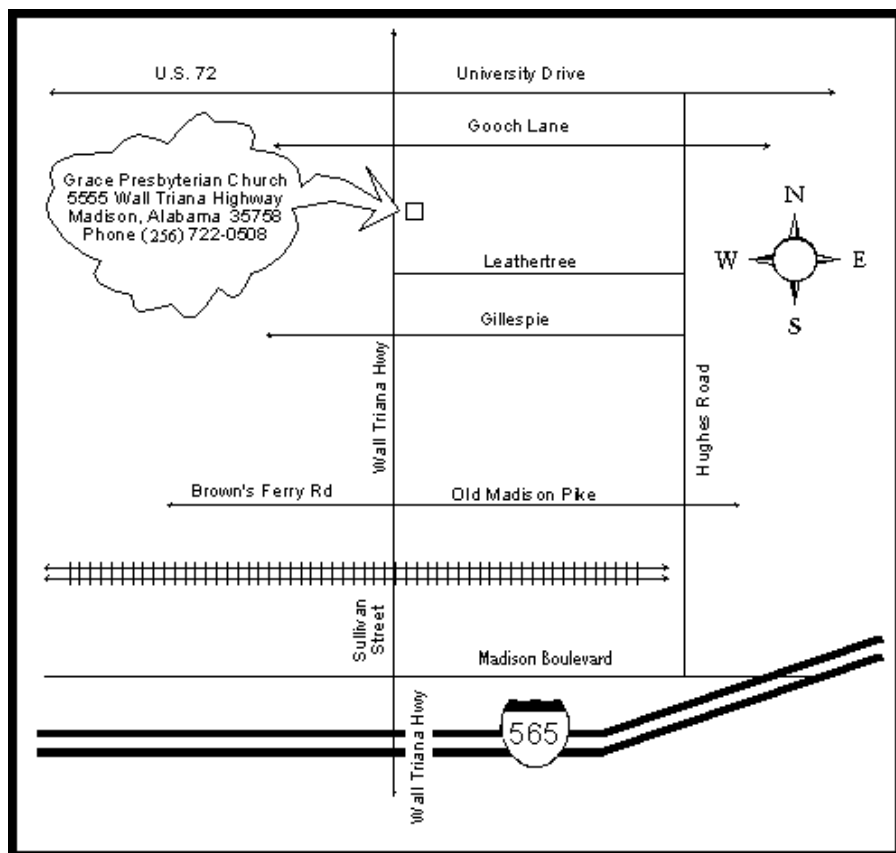

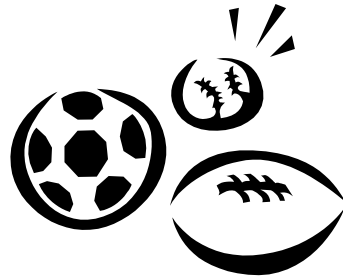

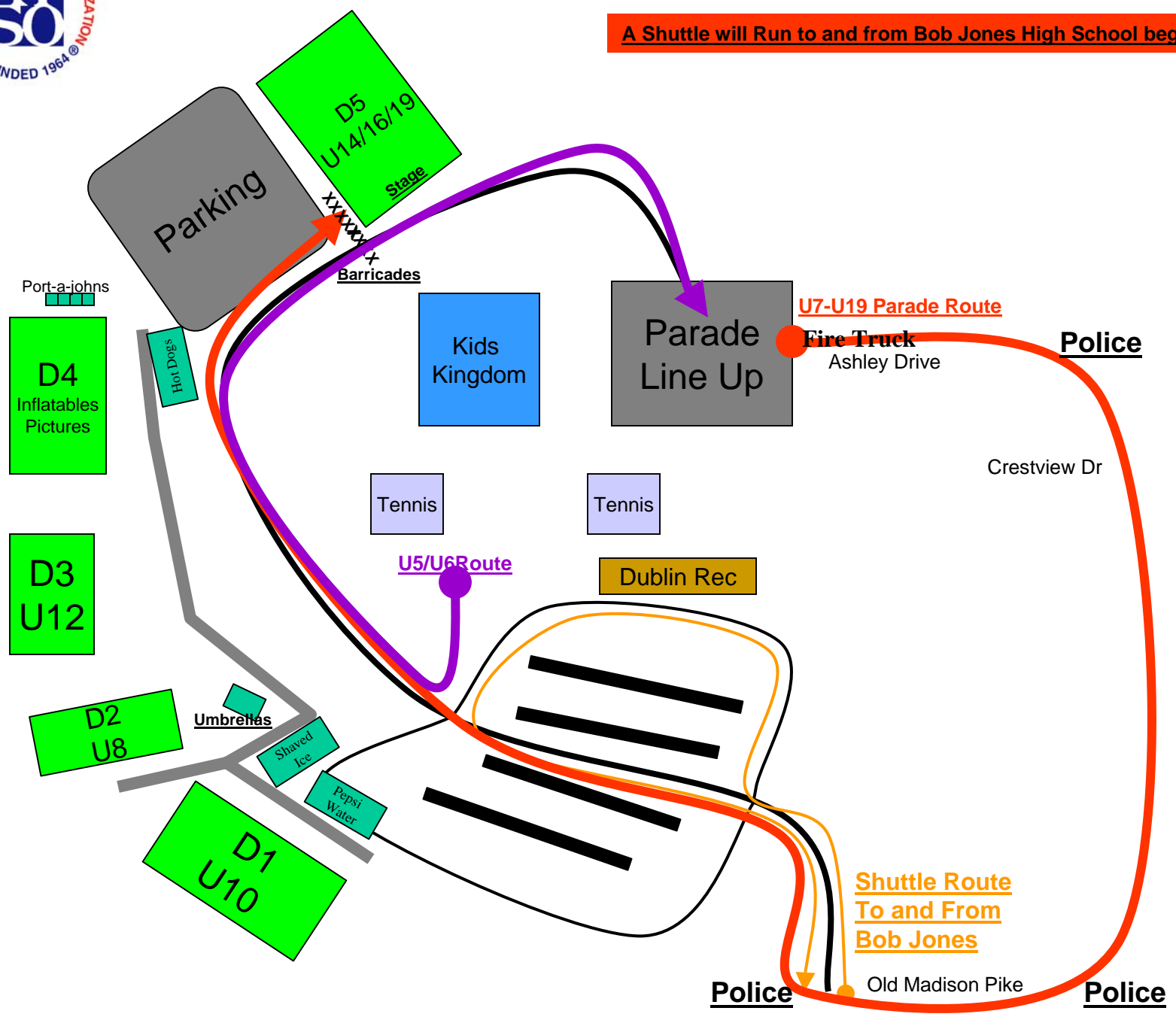
